2024 President's Report

Dear Members,

Thank you and welcome to the 2025 Annual General Meeting. It has been my great privilege to have served as President of CCAT and, with the support of our members and growing public interest in our Association, I believe 2024 has proved to be another productive year. As a first time President in the 55th year since founding of the CCAT, I have endeavoured to maintain the trajectory of our public profile so ably established by my predecessors: Daniel Chan, Lily Chan and Brian Chung.

Tasmania Chinese School, under the leadership of Principal Kim Phong and Administrator Gar Foong established since 1997 continues to support interest in Chinese Language and Culture for families. It remains a collective teacher, student and parent effort in learning and sharing and valuing diversity. The School's End of Year Ceremony was held at the Moonah Arts Centre on Saturday December 7, where students showcased their skills in the performing arts and Chinese language. An impressive number of students attained excellent results in the worldwide language Hanyushuiping Kaoshi (HSK examination).

CCAT held its 11th Lunar New Year Festival at Parliament Lawns Sunday February 2, celebrating the Year of the Snake. We were honoured to have The Lord Mayor of Hobart, Cr Anna Reynolds, Kerry Vincent MLC representing the Premier and officiating at the Opening Ceremony. We are grateful for the participation and support by many local organisations and Asian communities, particularly the Tasmanian Chinese Buddhist Academy (TCBAA) for decorating the festival site and adding to the visual spectacle by which the occasion is renowned. We must also thank all our sponsors including the Tasmanian Government and the City of Hobart for their continued support, our Festival Chairman James Lee for his vision and energy together with the team effort of supportive members and active volunteers for making the 2025 Festival a grand success. The festival organisation, work on stage along with the roaming lion and dragon, involved many strenuous hours. People like Debbie Chung make it look easy! The event was well covered by radio interviews (ABC Radio/ MMM) and television. Our event where many interstate visitors were interviewed was nationally featured by SBS.

The annual Chinese New Year Celebration Dinner Wednesday February 9 was catered by Kwan Ho Chinese Restaurant in the Boardwalk Gallery, Wrest Point. It was attended by 230 members, families and friends who shared fine foods, and an evening of entertainment organised by Ruby Lee and our Vice- President Yanqing Huo. We were honoured by the company of Simon Behrakis MP and the Consul-General Fang Xinwen who provided an address and joined in the raffle draw by donating soft toy snakes to the prize pool.

The Easter family picnic held on the Queens Domain is usually the first event on our calendar after the AGM with a Dongzhi 冬至节Festival being the last for 2024. The Dongzhi Festival where we come together to share dumpling soup (汤圆) was in line with two other festivals held at the clubhouse, Duanwujie 端午节 (Dragonboat Festival) and Zhongqiujie 中秋节(Harvest Moon

Festival). Thanks to Johnaton Liew who was well supported in the kitchen by volunteers and, apart from children's games and raffles, entertainment was variously provided by Anna, Liam and Fay-fay.

The Governor of Tasmania, Her Excellency the Honourable Barbara Baker AC invited us to a reception at Government House to celebrate the 55th anniversary of the establishment of the CCAT. This was held Monday August 5 and was attended by 150 people including members, fellow associations committees and supporters of CCAT. Ming Court, managed by Johnaton Liew provided such a memorable dinner to celebrate the anniversary occasion that a similar banquet was followed later in the year by Chongyang Jie 重阳节.

CCAT has a good working relationship with the Consulate General of China in Melbourne, and we have been invited to attend receptions in Melbourne celebrating the 75th anniversary of the Founding of the People's Republic of China Friday, September 27 and the Chinese New Year on Friday, January 17 2025. CCAT members also attended the Chinese Film Week in Hobart from October 31 hosted by the China Consulate General during 2024.

CCAT was a proud contributor to the Tasmania Museum & Art Gallery (TMAG) in the public exhibition 'Home: Here and Now' project sponsored by the National Foundation for Australia China Relations and with exhibits from members. I was one of the keynote speakers at the opening Thursday July 18. Following this, I was, as your President invited to address Rotary August 26 on being Chinese in Hobart, Friends of TMAG September 26 and University of the Third Age (U3A) November 21 'Moving on from the White Australia Policy'. Some of these were recorded. I have also attended forums and events organised by the Hobart City Council and the Department of Home Affairs, FOCAT, ACFS and the Terrapin Puppet Theatre.

At various times through the year our clubhouse has been used to serve MRC organised lunches and support ongoing sessions in mahjong and taichi. I ran some school holiday programs and also spoke to a group on the Health Benefits of learning a language Thursday, June 12. My intention is to see more of us stepping up to facilitate similar cultural past-times routines at the clubhouse as well as 'special' one off events.

My sincere thanks to the 2024 Management Committee for their ongoing support and hard work, which has enabled the CCAT to consolidate its reputable profile over the past year. In particular, I wish to thank Albert Ng for his continued involvement, unstinting support and efficient management of CCAT finances, Vice-President Yanqing Huo for her dedication and expertise, Phillip Chung for his secretarial support, Ruby Lee for her fun-loving approach in organising games for the Easter Picnic and Celebration New Year Dinner, Angel Chung for her networking organisation, Jan Everett who does our raffles, Angela Chung for always being there for the hard work, Johnaton Liew for providing delicious banquets through the year and of course, Harry Chung who is always on hand to do maintenance at the clubhouse and provide generous encouragement as only a big brother can.

I look forward to the continued expansion of the CCAT agenda which will see more members actively involved in cultural sessions as well as the clubhouse-based banquets. I wish all our members 2025 a happy, healthy, and prosperous Year of the Snake!

2024 年席会长报告

亲爱的会员们:

感谢并欢迎参加 2025 年度股东大会。我非常荣幸能够担任 CCAT 主席,在我们会员的支持和公众对我们协会日益增长的兴趣下,过去的2024 年是又一个富有成效的一年。在 CCAT 成立 55 周年,我首次成为主席,我一直努力维持我的前任的成果:陈源利、陈严莉莉和锺国兴精心为CCAT建立的良好的公众形象。

塔斯马尼亚中文学校自 1997 年成立以来,在校长 Kim Phong冯丽娟 和管理员 Gar Foong 冯家显的领导下,不断为塔州当地的家庭提供学习中国语言和文化的机会。它同时也是教师、学生和家长在学习、分享和重视多样性方面的集体努力。学校的年终典礼在 12 月 7 日星期六在 Moonah 艺术中心举行,学生们展示了他们的表演艺术和中文技能。大批学生在国际汉语水平考试中取得优异成绩。
